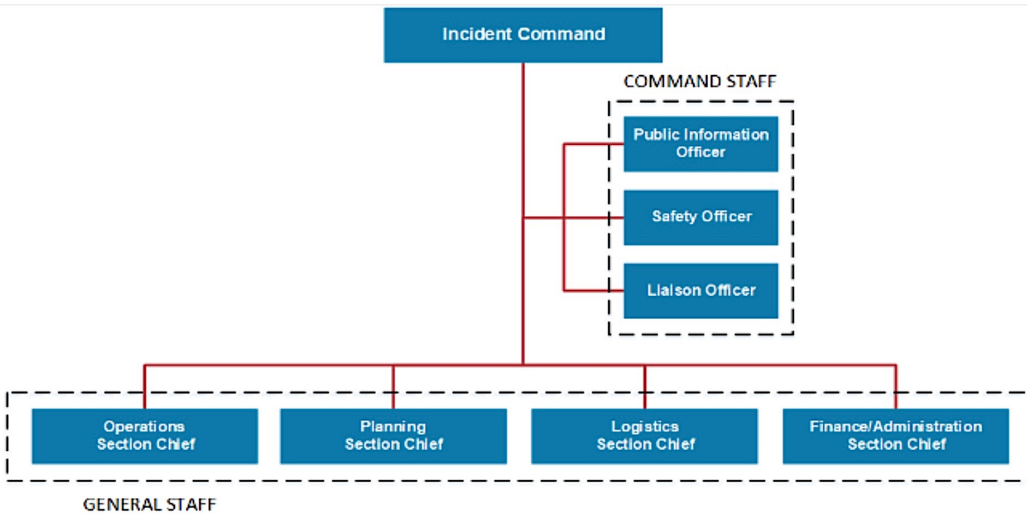
Incident Command System (ICS) Review

This ICS instruction will be focused on CERT’s role in disasters and public events.
