What is Terrorism?

- The U.S. Department of Justice defines terrorism as:
 - The unlawful use of force or violence against persons or property to intimidate or coerce a government, the civilian population, or any segment thereof, in furtherance of political or social objectives

What is terrorism?

- Recognizes the psychological impact it has on a society for many years
- Must be intended to coerce, intimidate, or convey some other message to a larger audience other than to the immediate victims
- Outside the precepts of international humanitarian law




Potential Indicators of Terrorism

Look for unusual/suspicious behavior –
out of the ordinary events or items

Unattended bags or leaking packages
People not dressed for the situation
People taking pictures of security arrangements




Until Help Arrives
CERT volunteers are NOT equipped or trained to respond to terrorist incidents
If you find yourself in a situation that you believe to be a terrorist attack, focus on the most lifesaving interventions:
 Move those in grave danger to a safe place Open airway Stop bleeding Prevent shock Consider the impacts of stress & fear on yourself and others
Be alert to the possibility of a second coordinated attack




